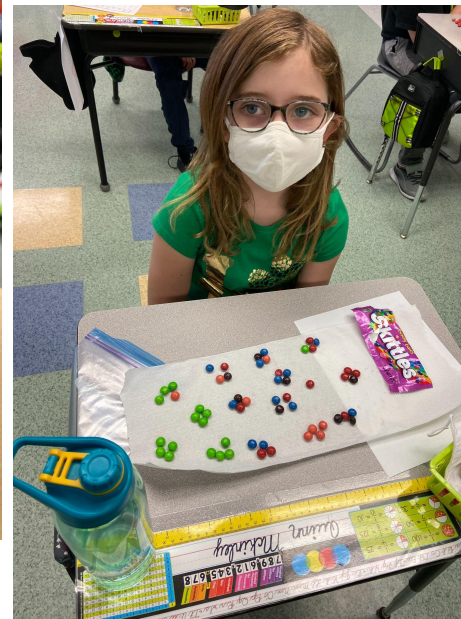
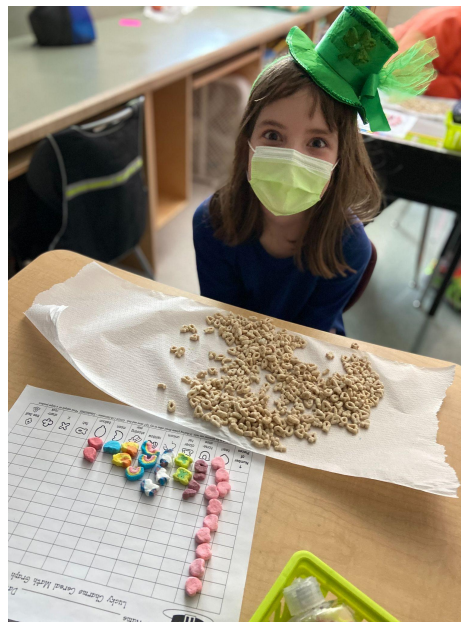
Paper Roller Coasters

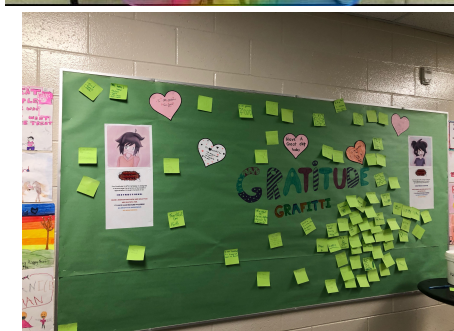
St. Patrick's Day Numeracy
