Stream of Dreams is an eco-education program that teaches entire schools and their communities about their local watershed, streams, rivers, and the ocean. They promote behavioural change to conserve and protect water, empower youth to make positive environmental impacts, and create a community art legacy. It's science, it's art, and it's fun! Every student and staff member at Aurora Middle School will learn about their local watershed and will receive simple instructions about how to work with the paint and then get to paint a fish

for the mural. LLB Kinsmen Club is sponsoring the project. The mural will be created on the fence between Aurora and Vera facing the road by LICA members and parent volunteers on the 3rd.
